

Schedule for F2F Students, as of Monday, November 23

The schedule for our current face-to-face students who are transitioning to virtual learning as of next Monday, is as follows.

- ➤ Monday through Thursday, 8:30 11:30 a.m.: full class instruction, "Live" online with the teacher, via Canvas
- ➤ Monday through Friday, 12:30 2:30 p.m.: small groups and 1:1 instruction time, per schedule set by classroom teacher (required—not optional, will be scheduled)
- ➤ Monday through Friday, 12:00 3:00 p.m.: Auxiliary teachers will be online to meet with students and answer questions in a *Google Meet*.

Next Wednesday is a half day of school, and all face-to-face classes will be done for the day at 11:30 a.m.

The Media Center is Open for Business!

The book drop for returns will also be in the lobby.

To request books: open the Clever App, access the Adams Media Center program. Login in the top right hand corner, and click on the blue bar "sign in with Google." All grade 2-5 students have done this before. If you struggle with this at all, please connect with your classroom teacher.
