

Protecting Our Eggs!

4th grade students at Adams wrapped up their **PLTW Collisions** module this week. After learning all about collisions, their final project was to design a vehicle restraint system to protect a vehicle passenger—an egg! Using the *engineering design process* students created vehicles that absorbed energy during a collision. To be successful, students were to drive their vehicles, with their egg passenger, down a ramp and crash into a wall without breaking the egg.

For an extra challenge, 4th graders had a chance to use even bigger ramps in Mrs. Washabaugh's class. The *Ultimate Egg Challenge* used longer ramps and ended with a ladder and an eight-foot ramp. 3 of 6 teams survived! Lauren Vanderbrook said, "The egg challenge was exhilarating and exciting at the same time. It taught me that it's important to have a safety restraint of some sort or to wear a helmet when you are in a vehicle. We need to protect our brains, especially during a collision!"



1st Grade Field Trip: Mid-Michigan Children's Museum

- Health care station, where students used different equipment and had fun imagining taking care of others.
