Tuesday's Weather Event and Your Child's Emotions

Everyone in school handled Tuesday's weather event very well. I am proud of the response from our staff, students and families. Everyone calmly banded together, listened, and took the necessary safety precautions. Most likely your child either did not have strong emotions about this event or, if they did, they've already talked about it with you.

However, sometimes feelings come up at a later date; if your child surprises you by talking about the event and how it made them feel, there are several steps you could take. Listen to what they have to say about it, ask them how it turned out (well), and encourage them to *look for the helpers* in tense situations like this. If they are still emotional, explore what they know about what happened, and clear up any misconceptions they may have (there was no tornado this time, weather like that is very unusual, the school is a very safe place to be in times of strong weather, there are lots of people there to help you). Reassure your child that they handled the event well, and they can manage potential future events, too.

Tuesday's Weather Event: Shelter in Place at Dismissal Time

It's rare to have a weather event that requires us to shelter in place. I have never (!) seen a weather event like Tuesday's, one that requires us to shelter in place when we would normally be dismissing students. It will likely not happen again, but if it does, please know that we will take all steps to keep your children safe, including sheltering through and after dismissal time, until it is safe for students to leave the building.

Community Outreach: Family Gifts

The *Sharing Tree* program is up and running, once again, for those in need. Parents may request a holiday gift (up to \$30) AND clothing for each family member living in their household. Tags are then placed around the community and shoppers purchase the items. Once tags are filled, the gifts are returned to the school for pickup by the family. **Gift request forms are in the office**. You may stop in and pick one up, or call us to request one to be sent home. Completed forms are due back in the office by **October 1, 2021**.
